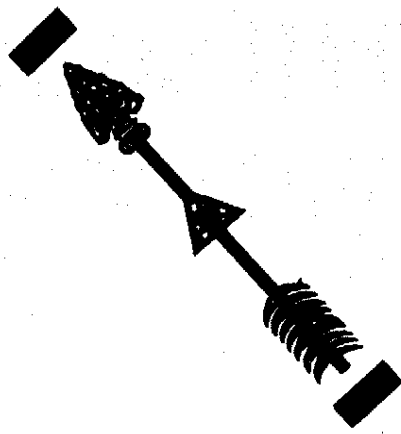
### ASHUK TSALIL

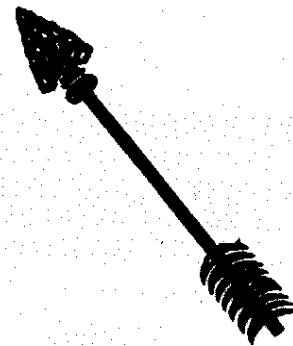
