

Dear Order of the Arrow Candidate:

Congratulations! This is your official confirmation that you have been selected as a candidate to the Order of the Arrow, Scouting's National Honor Society. Your selection indicates that your unit considers you an outstanding leader and camper. For your convenience, there will be four ordeals from which you may choose in 2012:

2012 Ordeal Weekends	
April 13-15	Camp Pigott
May 18-20	Camp Brinkley
June 1-3	Camp Parsons
September 7-9	Camp Pigott

Confirmations will not be mailed. If mailing your registration, please allow at least two weeks prior to the Ordeal of your choice. All candidates should report to the camp parking lot between 7:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Friday night. Please do not arrive after 9:00 p.m. Departure from camp is expected between 11:00 a.m.-12 p.m. on Sunday.

Online Registration is available at www.seattlebsa.org/ordealregistration. This method allows for greater accuracy & secure credit card payment.

The cost is \$65. This covers food, OA dues through June 30, 2013, OA Handbook, Ordeal sash, Lodge patch, and literature. This also covers the costs for Brotherhood membership, which is possible to obtain as early as 10 months after completing an Ordeal.

The BSA Medical form Part A & B must be signed by a parent or guardian and brought to check-in. If you have any medical or dietary concerns indicate on the registration form or contact the Inductions Adviser at inductions@tkopekwiskwis.org. Ordeal Essentials

- 1.) Completed & signed **BSA Medical Form** parts A&B.
- 2.) Correct and complete Scout or Scouter uniform. You will not need medals, merit badge sashes, neckerchiefs, nonofficial uniform parts or hats.
- 3.) Come fully prepared with sleeping bag and ground cloth and tarp for an overnight campout **ALONE** under the stars.
- 4.) You may bring a small personal tent in case of extremely foul weather.
- 5.) Small flashlight, pencil, pen, paper and knife.
- 6.) Work clothes, work gloves, personal toilet gear and personal First Aid kit with band-aids.
- 7.) **Boots and rain gear.**
- 8.) Eat prior to your arrival on Friday.
- 9.) **DO NOT BRING** food, candles, lanterns, LP cartridge lights or fire building material of any kind.
- 10.) Bring extra money to purchase additional OA and Lodge items available at the Trading Post.
- 11.) BSA membership card (if readily available).
- 12.) **ADULTS ONLY** - Ordeal work will require the use of skilled adults. If you have any trade skills that could be used, please let us know by writing the skill on the registration form or contacting the Inductions Adviser.
